# 2019 Paisley Denim Mataro

### Overview

This range of wines, named after fashionable fabrics, feature the iconic paisley design for which the company is named. The pattern became synonymous with the Scottish town of Paisley situated close to Glasgow and was the birthplace of Kirsten's great-great grandfather, who emigrated to Adelaide in 1839.

### Grape & Region

100% Mataro from Barossa Valley

### Vineyard

The Paisley Velvet Mataro was picked from a vineyard at the Southern end of the Barossa which has high quality Barossa soils, clay over limestone. The vineyard is slightly elevated from the Barossa floor and the temperatures are moderated by cooling evening breezes. The 30-year-old vines this wine is made from love the soils and aspect of this vineyard, producing low crops with only a few bunches per vine, resulting in a bright vibrant wine with some textural elements and great complexity.

### Vintage Conditions

The 2019 Vintage produced extremely low crops due to the low winter rainfall. With low bunch numbers and with small berries the resulting wines have immense richness, concentration and depth of flavour.

### Derek's Tasting Note

Mataro is an undiscovered gem in the Barossa with it being a staple of Barossa Winemaking for many generations. It thrives in the warm Mediterranean climate of the Barossa Valley. The Denim Mataro encompasses all the wonderful varietal characters of Mataro. It is a medium red colour with lifted spice, earthy notes raspberry and plum on the nose. The palate is medium bodied with great flavour intensity. Specifically raspberry fruit, some jubie notes, cherries, choc mint and eucalyptus. With typical textural Mataro tannins and a dense full palate, it goes well with all red meats. The wine is drinking beautifully now or can be cellared for up to ten years.
